Let sacred chants echo,

The Thyagaraja Temple at Thiruvottiyur, also known as Vadivudai Amman Temple, is one of the oldest and most revered shrines dedicated to Lord Shiva, located in the northern part of Chennai. This sacred site is the 20th Paadal Petra Shthalam in the Thondai Nadu region, glorified in the hymns of the Thevaram by the great Tamil Saiva saints – Appar, Sundarar and Thirugnanasambandar.



64 bronze statues of Nayanmars, accompanied by an equal number of devadasis, who performed sacred dances — half in devotion to Lord Thyagaraja and the rest to Goddess Vadivudai Amman.

Though the temple suffered damage during Malik Kafur’s invasions, it was lovingly restored by the Vijayanagara kings. Ancient scholars like Adi Shankaracharya are believed to have visited this temple, subduing dark forces through divine intervention.

In a fascinating episode of divine history, the Vedas, stolen and torn by the demons Madhu and Kaithaba, were hidden in the ocean depths. Lord Vishnu, unable to defeat them alone, prayed to Shiva and Parvati. Through their grace, he assumed the Matsya (fish) avatar, retrieved the Vedas, and brought them to this sacred temple, where they were reassembled and



sanctified. Thus, Thiruvottiyur became a spiritual epicenter for divine wisdom and cosmic order.

This place is also home to Thiruvottiyur Thyagayyar who was a carnatic composer and poet. The temple in the ancient days, had been a centre of learning as seen from the inscriptions in the temple. The inscriptions indicate specific subjects like *Purvamimansa* styled as *Pravahakarma*.

At the heart of the temple is Lord Aadhipureeswarar, represented in a mud mound form (putru), protected by a sacred armour that is removed only once a year on the

Karthigai Pournami — allowing darshan of the unadorned divine form. The presiding goddess, Vadivudai Amman (also known as Tiripurasundari), is enshrined in a separate sanctum. She is venerated as the embodiment of Gnana Shakti, the spiritual force of wisdom.

The temple also houses a rich pantheon of deities:

Agasalingam, Thiruvotrieswarar, Kuzhandhai Eesar, Kalyana Sundarar, Jambukeswarar, Sundareswarar, Suryan, Chandran, Gunalaya Vinayagar, Aruljothi Murugan, Valar Kali, and 27 star Lingams representing the Nakshatras (birth stars).

The temple offers daily Abhishekams (sacred baths) and special rituals such as:

1. Annabhishekam in Aipasi Pournami
2. Sangu Abhishekam during the third Monday of Karthigai
3. Child-boon pujas to Lord Kuzhandeeswarar

Devotees also pray to the Navagrahas and star Lingams for relief from astrological afflictions.

Festivals

The main festivals at the Thiruvottiyur Thyagarajar Temple include the annual Masi Brahmotsavam (Chariot Festival) in the Tamil month of Masi (February–March), Arudra Darisanam, Navaratri, and the special Pournami (full moon) ritual in the month of Karthikai. Other significant celebrations include Panguni Uthiram, Vasantha Utsavam, Thai Poosam, and Aadi Pooram.

Her grace is said to bestow all that a devotee seeks — beauty, intellect, devotion, humility, and more.

The temple’s sacred tree, the Makizha Maram, is revered as a divine Kalpavriksha, the celestial wish-fulfilling tree.

With a majestic seven-tiered gopuram, sprawling inner courtyards, and a tranquil sacred tank, the Thyagaraja Temple of Thiruvottiyur stands as a living testament to devotion, art, and ancient wisdom. It continues to inspire saints, scholars, and seekers through the ages.

Kashi temple security equipment to be upgraded

To strengthen security of Shri Kashi Vishwanath Dham, the control room and cameras will be modernized and upgraded soon, official sources said here today.

Sources said that besides, a state-of-the-art digital museum will be set up in the Dham. “To accelerate the commercial activities of the Dham, the allocation of vacant spaces in the Emporium will also be completed soon”.

On Thursday evening, under the chairmanship of Divisional Commissioner S Rajlingam, a meeting of Shri Kashi Vishwanath Temple Trust Parishad, Shri Kashi Vishwanath, Vishisht Kshetra, Vikas Parishad and Shri Kashi Vishwanath Temple Executive Committee was held in the Divisional Commissioner Auditorium.

In the meeting, a proposal was passed to renew the identity cards of daily visitors from time to time. A decision was also taken by Shri Kashi Vishwanath Temple Trust to establish a Vedic Education and Training Institute on the plot located in Mirzapur.

For easy darshan of devotees, the roads up to Shri Kashi Vishalakshi Mata Temple will be widened, for which the necessary buildings will be purchased soon. Apart from this, it was decided to provide devotees with Laddu Prasad and Rudraksha Mala as an alternative along with easy darshan.

Under the Sangam Tirtha Water Exchange Scheme, all the Jyotirlingas will be connected with this scheme.

TTD to close Tirumala, other temples for eclipse

The Tirumala temple and many local temples come under the umbrella of TTD, will remain closed on September 7 for lunar eclipse.


According to the Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanam (TTD), pilgrim worship will remain suspended at the hill temple from 3.30 p.m. on September 7 till 3 a.m. on September 8.

IT was a customary practice to close down the temple six hours prior to the actual eclipse time. The lunar eclipse will begin at around 9:50 pm on September 7 and end at around 1:31am on September 8.

Many temples managed by TTD including Tiruchanoor, Govindaraja Swamy, Sri Kodandarama Swamy, Srinivasa Mangapuram, Appalayagunta and many

more will remain closed from the afternoon session on September 7 following Lunar Eclipse.

After performing the Suddhi pujas, the temple reopens Darshan for devotees. In Tiruchanoor the temple will close by 2:15 p.m. on September 7 and open by 8 a.m. on September 8 while in Govindaraja Swamy will close by 3:30 p.m. and opens up darshan from 9:30 a.m. onwards. At Srinivasa Mangapuram the temple door closes by 3:30 pm and darshan commences by 8:30 a.m.In Kapilatheertham the temple will close by 3 p.m. and open doors for darshan by 7 a.m. on Monday. Similarly in several outside temples of TTD the temple doors will closes by 2 p.m. on September 7 and open by 3 a.m. on September 8.
